On Saturday, May 26, Orange Show Speedway is presenting "A Race to Remember – Honoring Our Heroes" to salute the men and women who are serving or have served in all branches of the U.S. military and pay tribute to those who have sacrificed their lives in defense of our freedom.

Military installations throughout Southern California have been contacted with invitations for all military and civilian support personnel and their families to attend the evening's stock car races and the 92nd National Orange Show Festival as guests of the speedway, the National Orange Show Events Center and the Match Corporation. In addition, the Match Corporation is providing free admission to the speedway to all those purchasing a festival ticket.

Thus far, representatives of the Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center at Twentynine Palms, San Diego Naval Station, the Marine Corps Base at Camp Pendleton, Fort Irwin, March Air Reserve Base and the Veterans Administration have confirmed that personnel from their facilities will be in attendance. Representatives of the Riverside National Cemetery and the Ontario Airport chapter of the USO also will be in attendance.

Pre-race festivities will include the first military flyover in Orange Show Speedway history. Independent country music star BECCA will sing the National Anthem and "God Bless America," the various military units will have vehicles and equipment on display, representatives of "A Million Thanks," a program created by Orange Lutheran High senior Shauna Fleming, will be on hand to help visitors create their own "thank you" notes to the troops. Commemorative T-shirts also will be on sale, with all proceeds going to the National Cemetery and USO.

The racing program for the evening includes the Lucas Oil Outlaw Figure 8s, BSR West Late Models, Leno's Rico Taco Legends Cars and a Demolition Derby. All drivers will participate in an on-track autograph session from 5:30 to 6:15 p.m. and racing will begin about 6:30 p.m. The evening will conclude with a Fireworks show.
